




| STAGE-1 CITY MIDDLE DISTANCE RACE (NEW MAP) | GESİ/KAYABAĞ |

| Eighty percent of the map comprises residential areas and houses, while the roads are predominantly paved. The remaining twenty percent typically features terrain elements such as dovecotes and caves. Elevation on the map ranges from 1300 to 1350, with runnability and visibility fluctuating between good and very good. It is advisable to use standard running shoes. | |



| The terrain features numerous contour details, with rocky areas appearing intermittently. It presents a technical and runnable landscape; however, the green areas pose challenges to running in certain locations. The elevation on the map ranges from 1800 to 1950, with favorable runnability and visibility. It is advisable to use spiked orienteering shoes. | |


TRANSPORT

Departure times will be published in Bulletin-3.






AWARDS



TIMING SYSTEM


The SPORTident AIR (+) electronic timing system will be utilized for the competitions.


The following considerations should be made regarding timing:

If you possess your own SI device, you may utilize it during the competition. To do so, you must provide your SI number at the time of registration. After completing your final race, you are required to return the rented card to the organizing body. In the event of loss, you will be obligated to pay the SI fee of £2500.






EXPLORE KAYSERI

GESI VINEYARDS AND DOVECOTES

The pigeon houses depicted on our initial day map represent some of the intriguing structures in Kayseri. These houses offer shelter to birds that have not yet been domesticated, shielding them from extreme temperatures, snow, winter storms, and providing sustenance during times when food is scarce. Additionally, they protect the birds from predation by wild animals. Pigeon houses are comprised of three primary sections known as the "pigeon room," "tower," and "tunnel."



MOUNT ERCIYES

Mount Erciyes, situated 10 km from our second stage, ranks as the fifth highest extinct volcano in Turkey and the tallest in the Central Anatolia Region, with an elevation of 3,917 meters. Its summit, which pierces the clouds, along with the perpetual snow adorning its peak, renders it a symbol of Kayseri, evoking a sense of the divine in those who behold its grandeur. Mount Erciyes remains significant for winter tourism, mountain climbing, and plateau tourism throughout the year. Its eruptions, occurring 30 million years ago, contributed to the formation of Cappadocia.





EXPLORE KAYSERI

HISTORIC TALAS AND OTTOMAN THOROUGHFARE

Talas, located 4 km from our third stage, has been home to numerous civilizations throughout history, including Mazaka, Tabal, Cilicia, Cappadocia, Med, Persian, Kayrus, Roman, Byzantine, Danishmend, Seljuk, and Ottoman. It has served as a confluence for individuals from diverse religions and cultures. Presently, the district captivates visitors with its narrow streets, towering stone houses, and historical edifices. Additionally, one can find traditional handicrafts, souvenir shops, and establishments offering local delicacies.



SOĞANLI VALLEY AND RUİNS

The Soğanlı Archaeological Site, situated 40 km from our fourth stage, has served as a settlement since the Roman Period. The Romans utilized the rock formations on the valley slopes as cemeteries, while the Byzantines repurposed them as churches. From the 4th century AD, Soğanlı emerged as a significant center of Christianity in Cappadocia, retaining its prominence through the 7th and 8th centuries. In addition to numerous churches and monasteries hewn from the rock, Soğanlı is home to thousands of dovecotes, caves, and shelters.
